## 2010 CONDITIONS

By signing the tournament entry form, competitors acknowledge they understand and agree to all Tournament conditions. Failure to adhere to these conditions may result in a competitor(s) being prohibited from starting or being excluded from the remainder of the Tournament.

**PACE OF PLAY:** Slow play is becoming a significant issue in junior tournaments across Australia. SAJG will strictly enforce 'Pace of Play' rulings. Each group MUST maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding it. Penalties WILL be issued to individuals in groups who by their pace of play contribute to such delay. Warnings will not necessarily be issued.

- 1. TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE:** shall consist of representatives of SAJG and Cobram Barooga GC/Tocumwal GC. The Tournament Committee (TC) shall have sole management of the tournament with full rights to vary the conditions or time of play.
- 2. RULES:** The Tournament shall be played in accordance with the rules of golf as adopted by the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, together with such local rules as are applicable on the golf courses. Any rule or decision made by the Tournament Committee or its representative(s) shall be final. Competitors must use golf equipment compliant with that named in the current R & A and/or USGA approved lists. In the event of extreme hot weather the TC reserves the right to reduce the duration of the event e.g. If heat is extreme then change the event from 72 holes to 54 holes.
- 3. PRACTICE ROUNDS:** are available on Wednesday December 15, 2010 from 2pm for Murray River Junior Masters entrants. Please call pro shops to book.
- 4. REGISTRATION:** All competitors must register for the tournament at least 30 minutes prior to their allocated round one tee time.
- 5. CADDIES ARE PERMITTED:** Caddies are permitted as per the Rules of Golf. Caddies must respect the rights of the competitors at all times. Caddies, whether they be parents or friends are reminded to avoid placing unnecessary pressure on the competitors. No advice should be given to a competitor by a caddy unless requested. Nor should a caddy criticise the decisions or efforts of a competitor at any stage during the event. The TC as organisers of the event reserves the right to withdraw the caddy rights of any person who it believes is not acting in the best interests of the competitor or the ideals of the event.
- 6. GOLF CARTS** or similar automotive assistance: Competitors and Caddies will not be permitted to ride on or in any form of automotive locomotion during play, unless authorised by the TC.
- 7. DRAW & STARTING TIMES:** The Tournament Committee reserves the right to amend the draw if required. However it is a condition of Tournament that in the absence of circumstances that warrant invoking Rule 33-7, if the player arrives after his/her starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is disqualification. In the event of inclement or extreme weather, or for any other reason the Tournament Committee may see fit to warrant the circumstance, the Tournament Committee may either shorten the Tournament or appoint another day for the completion of the Tournament. Once a draw is completed, no refund will be available except upon production of a medical certificate.
- 8. SCORE CARDS:** Signed by the marker and counter signed by the player must be returned to the person appointed by the Tournament Committee no longer than 10 minutes after completion of the round.
- 9. 72 HOLES:** All players must play the entire 72 holes (unless genuinely injured or ill or extenuating family circumstances prevail).
- 10. HANDICAPS:** Boys and Girls handicaps will not be re-handicapped during the event.
- 11. TIES:** In the event of a tie a sudden death playoff will occur to determine the overall Boys and Girls Champions. Playoff hole/s will be determined by the TC. All other ties throughout the tournament will be decided on a count back in the manner laid down by Golf Australia. Please note: No player is eligible to win more than one major trophy.
- 12. PROTESTS:** any protest(s) must be made to the Tournament Committee no later than 10 minutes after the conclusion of the day's play. The decision of the Tournament Committee shall be final.
- 13. ENTRIES:** All entries must be made on the Tournament entry form and received by the Tournament Committee at the specified date and time of close of entries. Faxed entries without payment will not be granted a place in the field unless the accompanying entry fee is received by the date and time of close of entries. Entries are restricted to amateur golfers under the age of 21 years as at 16/12/10. A ballot may be required depending upon entry numbers as of December 6, 2010. Once a draw is completed, no refund will be available except upon production of a medical certificate. Entry implies acceptance of the Conditions of Play governing the championship and the TC as organisers reserve the right to alter Conditions of Play without prior notice. A minimum of 8 entries is required to constitute an age division. If insufficient entries are received players will move up to the next age division.
- 14. DRESS REGULATIONS:** all competitors and spectators must adhere to the dress regulations of the host clubs. Shirts must have a collar, no jeans or denim of any type. Short socks may be worn. Soft spiked golf shoes must be worn.
- 15. GENERAL BEHAVIOUR:** Competitors must deposit all their rubbish in the appropriate receptacles. Sand/soil buckets must be carried and used if available and returned to the appropriate place at the conclusion of play. All divots and pitch marks must be repaired irrespective of the availability of sand/soil buckets. All competitors MUST NOT use unacceptable language before, during or after play, nor throw or mistreat their own or fellow competitors' equipment. Use of mobile telephones on the course by a competitor, caddy or spectator is prohibited.
- 16. MARKETING & PROMOTION:** All competitors by way of entry give SAJG, Cobram Barooga GC/Tocumwal GC and sponsors full permission to use for publicity and marketing purposes, photographs and images taken during the course of conducting this Tournament.
