



## 2010 REGIONAL SERIES

The REGIONAL SERIES in 2010 will encompass 12 events (approx) around Victoria over 10 months, from January to October. It is designed to take competition experiences broadly across Victoria, primarily for established junior golfers and better players, but also for younger players wishing to start playing golf at a competitive level.

The REGIONAL SERIES is modelled along the lines of the Fedex Cup played on the USPGA Tour. Regional Series Points (gross) and Divisional Points (nett) and are allocated at each event, with bonus allocations for the 4 SAJG Regional Series "Majors", which attract a 500-point bonus for each placing. A "Points Table" will be updated on the SAJG website after each event. The aggregate of the best 4 points scores across the year will comprise the final points tally for the "Regional Series Cup", with the 3 best points scores comprising the final points tally for each of the Divisions. Points are not able to be carried between divisions.

The REGIONAL SERIES will be played over 18 holes for juniors with handicaps, the maximum handicap being 36 (boys) and 45 (girls), with play being stroke for players up to and including 20 h'cap, and stableford for players up to and including 45 h'cap (Golf Link numbers must be provided with entry).
