## 2010 TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

### PAGE 1 of 2 - TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

The 2010 Stuart Appleby Signature Tournament (hereafter referred to as 'the Tournament') shall be played over 18 holes in stroke format.

#### **PACE OF PLAY**

**Slow play is becoming a significant issue in junior tournaments across Australia.**

**SAJG will strictly enforce 'Pace of Play' rulings. Each group MUST maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding it. Penalties WILL be issued to individuals in groups who by their pace of play contribute to such delay. Warnings will not necessarily be issued.**

1. **Tournament Committee**

The Tournament Committee shall consist of representatives of SAJG and/or The Heritage. The Tournament Committee shall have sole management of the tournament with full rights to vary the conditions or time of play.

2. **Rules**

The Tournament shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews, together with such local rules as are applicable on the course over which the Tournament takes place. Any rule or decision made by the Tournament Committee or its representative(s) shall be final. Competitors must use golf equipment compliant with that named in the current R & A and/or USGA approved lists.

3. **Protests**

Any protest(s) must be made to the Tournament Committee no later than 10 minutes after the conclusion of play. The decision of the Tournament Committee shall be final.

4. **Draw and Starting Times**

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to amend the draw if required. However it is a condition of the Tournament that in the absence of circumstances that warrant waiving in Rule 33-7, if the player arrives at his/her starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is disqualification.

In the event of inclement or extreme weather, or for any other reason the Tournament Committee may see fit to warrant the circumstance, the Tournament Committee may either shorten the Tournament or appoint another day for the completion of the Tournament.

After the draw is completed, no refund will be available except upon production of a medical certificate.

5. **Score Cards**

The completion of final scores by each player shall take place in the designated Score Area. Score cards signed by the marker and counter signed by the player must be lodged with the Official in the Score Area no longer than 10 minutes after the completion of the player's round.

6. **Ties**

In the event of ties for age division prizes a competitor's placing will be determined by count back. Boys and girls overall champions will be decided by sudden death playoff if required.

7. **Practice**

The Heritage is a private club, for use by members and guests only. Any arrangements for practice rounds must be made directly with the club.

8. **Caddies**

Caddies are permitted as per the Rules of Golf (see 2 above). Caddies must respect the rights of the competitors at all times. Caddies, whether they are parents or friends are reminded to avoid placing unnecessary pressure on the competitors. Caddies should not criticise the decisions or efforts of a competitor at any stage during the event. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to withdraw caddy rights of any person it believes is not acting in the best interests of the competitor or the ideals of SAJG.

9. **Dress Standards – APPLIES TO PLAYERS, CADDIES & SPECTATORS ALIKE**

All competitors, supporters and spectators must adhere to the dress regulations of The Heritage. Shirts must have a collar and be worn tucked in.

**No jeans, denim of any description, Cargo pants, cargo shorts or midriff tops will be permitted on the golf course, in the clubhouse or in the areas surrounding the clubhouse.**

Runners/sports shoes are not permitted in the clubhouse. It is preferred that golf shoes not be worn in the clubhouse. Please ensure you bring a change of shoes to wear into the clubhouse for the presentation of prizes.

Short, plain white socks may be worn. Non-metal spiked golf shoes MUST be worn. Metal spikes are not permitted.

**PLAYERS, CADDIES, SPECTATORS WHO ARE DRESSED INAPPROPRIATELY OR BEHAVE POORLY WILL BE REQUIRED TO LEAVE THE PREMISES.**

10. General Courtesy & Behaviour

Sand/soil buckets must be carried, used and returned to the appropriate place at the conclusion of play.  
All divots and pitch marks must be repaired irrespective of the availability of sand/soil buckets.  
Competitors, supporters and spectators MUST NOT use unacceptable language before, during or after play, nor throw or mistreat their own or fellow competitor's equipment.  
Competitors must deposit all their rubbish in the appropriate bins/receptacles.  
Smoking or the consumption of alcohol by competitors is strictly prohibited.  
Use of mobile telephones on the course or in the clubhouse by a competitor, caddie or spectator is prohibited.

11. Entries

All entries must be made on the Tournament entry form and received by the Tournament Committee at the specified date and time of close of entries. Faxed entries without credit card details will not be granted a place in the field unless the accompanying entry fee is received by the date and time of close of entries.

Entries are restricted to amateur golfers under the age of 18 years as at November 21, 2010 who hold an official Golf Australia handicap, or who are a member of a golf club registered with a recognised overseas golf association and whose handicap can be verified by that respective association.

The Tournament Committee shall have the right to ballot entries according to handicap, order of receipt, or if necessary set handicap or age grades for competitors, and may refuse entry of any person without being required to give reason for such refusal. A Minimum of 8 entries is required to constitute an age division.

The competitors GolfLink number (or current handicap printout) must accompany the entry form.

Entry implies acceptance of the Conditions of Play governing the tournament with the Tournament Committee reserving the right to alter Conditions of Play without prior notice.

12. Golf carts or similar automotive assistance

Competitors and Caddies will not be permitted to ride on or in any form of automotive locomotion during play, unless authorised by the Tournament Committee.

13. Marketing & Promotion

All competitors by way of entry give SAJG full permission to use for publicity and marketing purposes, photographs and images taken during the course of conducting this Tournament.

14. Disclaimer / Waiver

Competitors, caddies and spectators understand and acknowledge that entry to the 2010 Stuart Appleby Signature Tournament is done so waiving SAJG or the Host Club of liability for personal injury, property damage or loss, that may be sustained to/by any competitor, caddie or spectators as a result of participation in the Tournament unless caused by the proven negligence of SAJG or the Host Club. Competitors authorise SAJG, the Tournament Committee or its representatives to seek medical assistance as they see fit and agree to meet all expenses as incurred. By way of entering the Tournament, competitors fully understand and consent to the activities to be undertaken and to the location of the activities.
