

"VICTORIAN UNDER 16 JUNIOR GOLF CLASSIC"

Australian Pitch'n'Putt, Wellington Rd, Mulgrave

PROGRAM *The classic will be conducted over 18 holes stroke play (approx time 2 - 2.5 hours)*
ELIGIBILITY *Male and female players under the age of 16 years as at time of the event are eligible.*

CONDITIONS

1. THE EVENT

The Victorian Under 16's Junior Golf Classic will be played over 18 holes stroke play.

2. CHAMPIONSHIP COMMITTEE

The Championship Committee shall consist of SAJG and APP Personnel. The Championship Committee shall have the sole management and control of the Championship with full power at any time, to alter or vary any of the conditions.

3. ENTRIES

Entries will be limited to 72 players in order of receipt and close 1 week prior to the event.

4. AGE REQUIREMENT

Entrants must be under 16 years of age on the day of play.

5. RULES

Competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, Scotland, together with such local rules as are in force on the course over which the competition takes place. If a dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the Championship Committee whose decision shall be final.

6. MAXIMUM STROKES PER HOLE

Once a player has eight strokes on any hole, the ball must be lifted with 8 placed against the relevant hole on the scorecard. No further strokes are permitted on the hole.

7. PROTESTS

The decisions of the Championship Committee will be final in all matters relating to the tournament. Protests must be made to the Championship Committee no later than 15 minutes after conclusion of his/her round.

8. TIES

In the event of a tie or ties for any age category, winner will be decided by countback.

9. SCORE CARDS

Score Cards, signed by the marker and countersigned by the competitor must be returned to the person appointed by the Championship Committee as soon as possible following completion of each round.

10. BAD WEATHER

The Championship Committee may in the event of bad weather or for any other reason either shorten the tournament or appoint another day or days for completion of event.

11. DRAW AND STARTING TIMES

A draw will be made by the Championship Committee. The Committee has the power to amend the draw or substitute another player for any competitor who is not at the tee at the time appointed to play. Draw will be posted at www.stuartappleby.com.au

12. ADULT PRESENCE

Each group must be accompanied by an adult during the event whose responsibilities include safety and scoring where necessary.

13. NETT TROPHIES

Nett trophies will be decided by the Australian Pitch'n'Putt (par 3) Calloway Handicapping System.

14. AIRSWINGS

Airswings are to be counted as one stroke.

15. CLUB LIMIT

Each player shall start their round with not more than fourteen clubs. However, it is suggested a putter, sand iron or wedge plus seven iron should be utilised.
