CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. Competitions shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf, as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews, Scotland subject to such Local Rules in force on the course over the period of the competition.
2. The Match Committee of the Tournament will settle any dispute or protest.
3. The Match Committee will have the power to alter the conditions should they deem it necessary.
4. Competitors must report to registration 30 minutes before their appointed hit off time.
5. A competitor must be under the age of 18 years as at 11/12/2010.
6. All competitors must hold a current VGA or WGA handicap.
7. In the event of a tie a sudden death playoff will occur to determine the overall champions. Playoff holes to be determined by the TC, all other ties throughout the tournament will be decided on a count back in the manner laid down by Golf Australia.
8. Slow Play – Slow play is becoming a significant issue in junior tournaments across Australia. Murray Downs will strictly enforce 'Pace of Play' rulings. Each group MUST maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding it. Penalties will be issued to individuals in groups who by their own pace of play contribute to such delay. Warnings will not necessarily be issued.
