



STANDARD CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR ALL SAJG EVENTS

1. Competitions shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Club of St Andrews, Scotland subject to such local rules as are in force on the course over which the competition takes place.
2. All competitors must use a golf ball and equipment as approved by the R & A.
3. SAJG management, whose decision will be final, will decide any dispute or protest.
4. SAJG management to make all arrangements and to have full power to alter the conditions, should they deem it desirable, and shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
5. Competitors must be ready to start at the appointed time. Only in special circumstances approved by SAJG management, may competitors be permitted to start at a later time.
6. SAJG management reserves the right to limit the number of entries. Preference may be given according to handicap or entry date.
7. All competitors are required to comply with the dress regulations of the Host Venue.
8. SAJG Standard Conditions of Entry relating to drugs, Accidents, Personal Risk and Medical Conditions, Heat and Privacy will apply.
9. SAJG management may provide in the conditions of an event that, in potentially dangerous situations, play shall be discontinued immediately following a suspension of play.
10. No substitutes are accepted, unless otherwise stated on the entry form and approved by SAJG.
11. Caddies are permitted as per the Rules of Golf.

Inclement Weather

Play will proceed in inclement weather unless the golf course scheduled for the day's play is closed, or it is deemed by SAJG/Host Venue that participants will be at risk if play proceeds.

Entry Fees

Entry fees (in full) must accompany the official event entry form. No refund of entry fees is applicable once the event draw is published.
